One of their flagship projects is Accelerator - a successful youth business internship and mentoring programme.

Accelerator helps employers to become involved in the education process by giving them a chance to explain the employment opportunities available in their business.

Students and business mentors get to know each other over the course of the programme and this helps the student to understand the pathway to their chosen career.
